<p>The book we are focusing on from the power or reading:</p> <p>The Iron Man - Ted Hughes</p>  <p><u>Writing Outcomes</u> Recounts, Persuasive writing, writing in character, drama and role-play</p> <p><u>Key Vocabulary:</u></p> <p>Iron Man, Hogarth, farmer, scrap metal, Space Bat - Angel-Dragon, Australia, Astronomer, contest, Star Spirit.</p>	<p>Multiplication and division.</p> <p>Core work will be from White Rose Maths supplemented with additional materials as required to meet pupil's needs.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Repeated addition • Inverse • Related calculations  <p><u>Key Vocabulary:</u> Multiply, multiples, times table, counting in and back, long multiplication, division, sharing repeated subtractions, inverse, altogether, equal, group, remainder</p>	<p>Our topic: Power it up! Electricity</p> <p>To identify common appliances that run on electricity. To classify and record appliances as mains or battery operated.</p> <p>To understand the difference between mains and battery-operated appliances.</p> <p>To understand that Electricity can be dangerous.</p> <p><u>Key Vocabulary:</u> Appliances, battery, cell, circuit, component, conductor, current, electricity, insulator, lamp, motor, switch, voltage</p>
