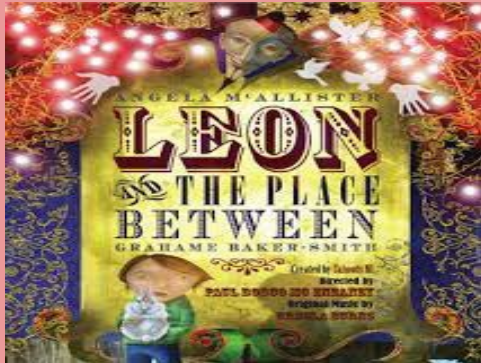
Leon and the Place Between - Angela Mc Allister and Grahame Baker-Smith
